Lucas, what was your favorite part about January as chief?

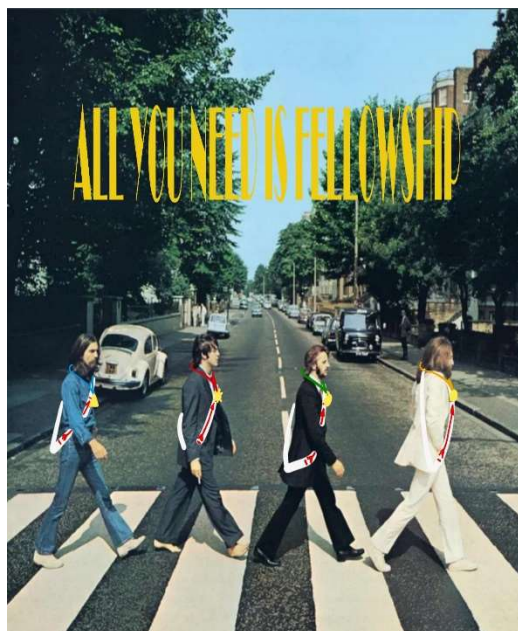
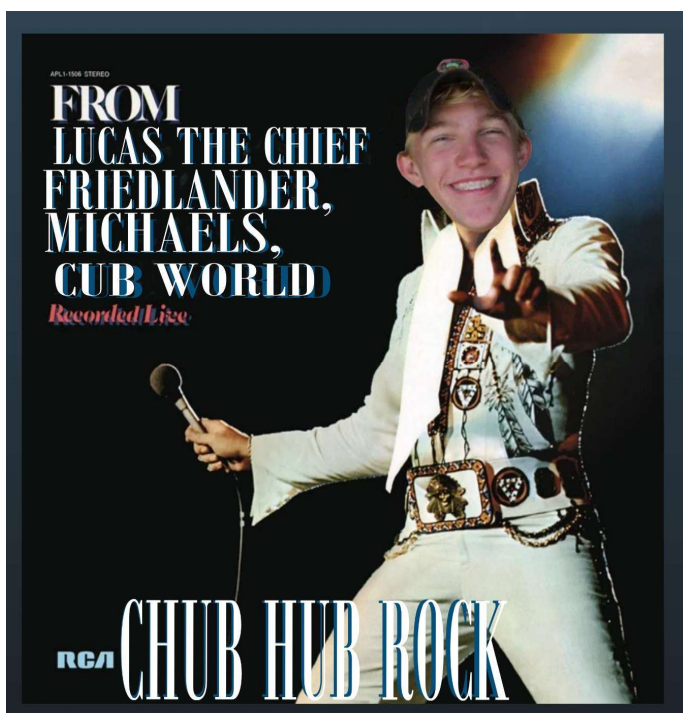
1.) My favorite part about January as Chief was going to the Klondike and seeing the chapters taking initiative to do their own events without help from the lodge, since we didn't have an event in January.

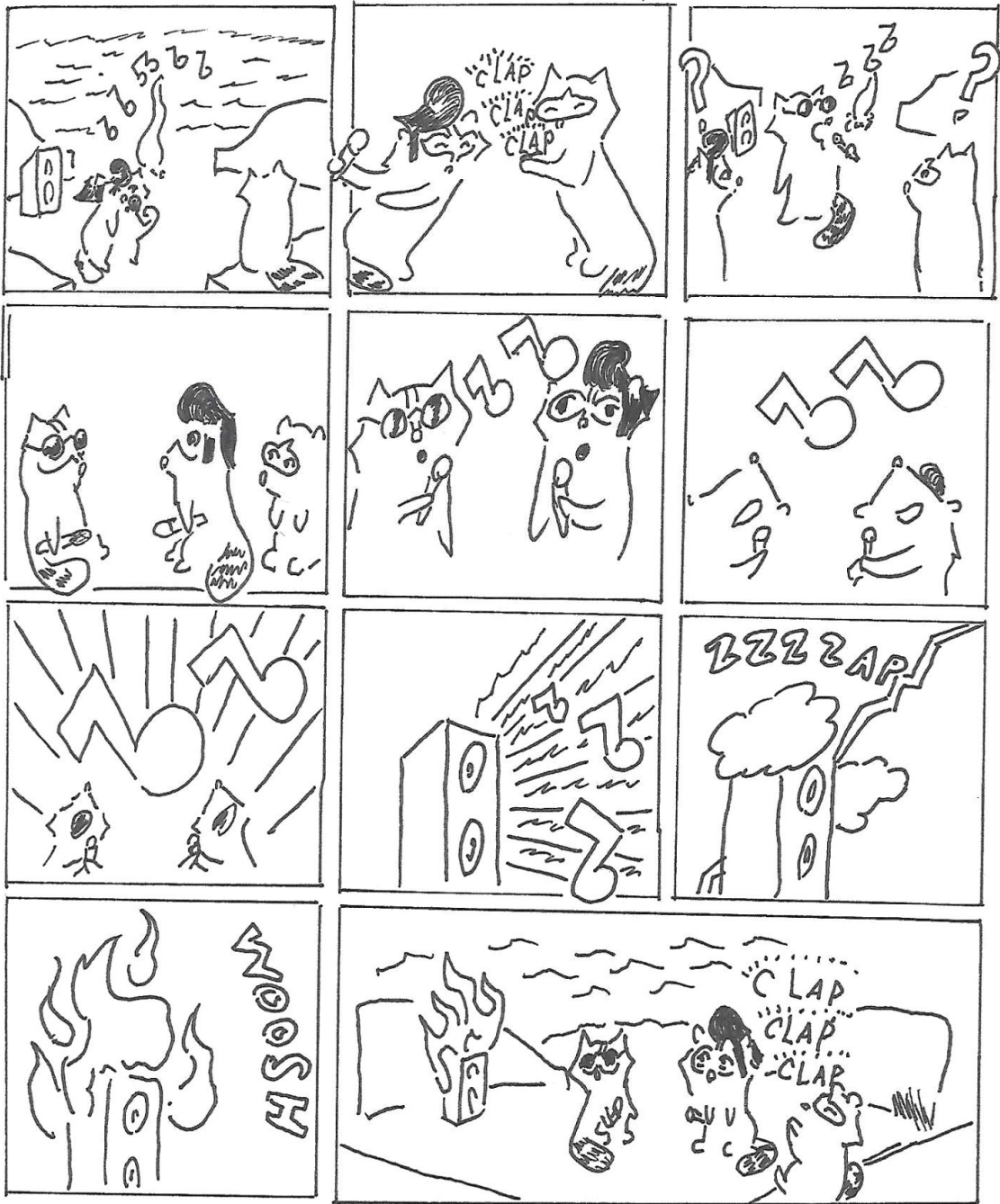
